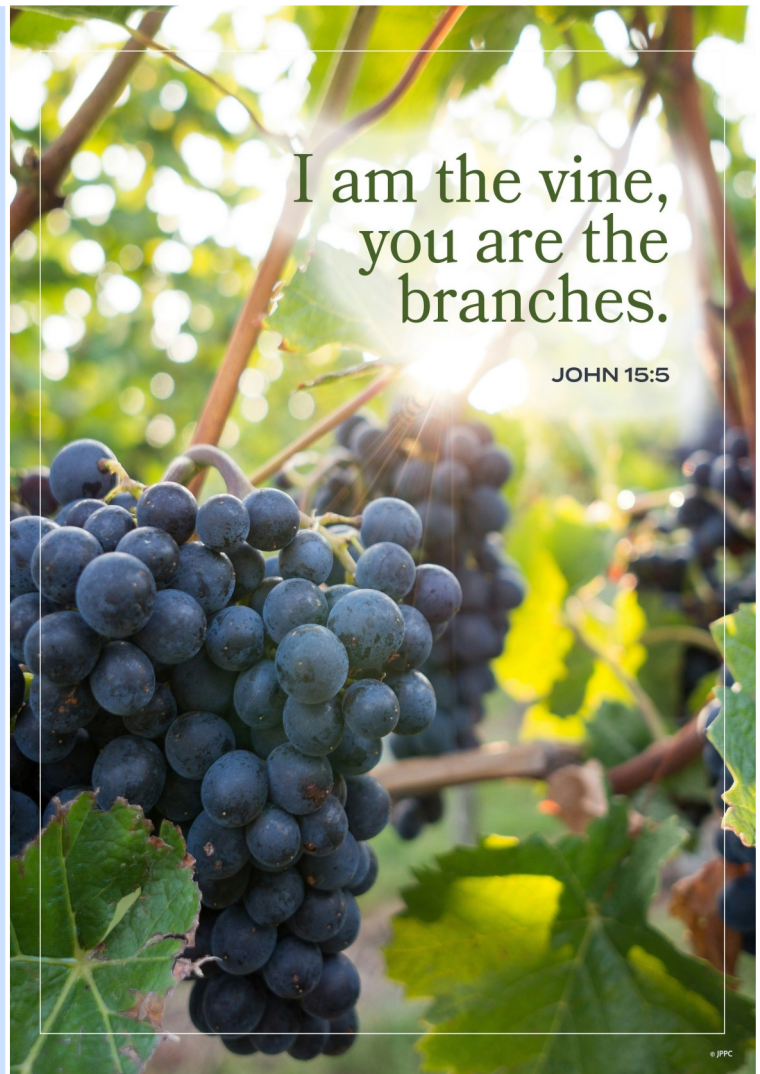

Sacrament of Marriage: Necessary preparation requires that an appointment be made with one of our priests or deacon. Please call the rectory. Arrangements should be made at least 1 year to the date desired.

Sacrament of the Sick: Priests may be called day or night for anointing of the extremely sick or dying. **EMERGENCY LINE:** call the rectory and press 2. Parishioners homebound & in need of visitation for Holy Communion, please call the rectory during business hours. If your loved one is hospitalized, speak to hospital's pastoral care.

Quinceañeras or Sweet 16: The young lady should have completed or be in preparation to complete all her sacraments.

Funerals: Funeral arrangements are typically made through the funeral home. The family member in charge of arrangements may contact us.

From Our Rector

Do you remember your First Communion? For many of us, this day was a blur. Many of us were young when we first received our Lord in the Eucharist, while others may have been adults. No matter

when we received Him, we know that our lives changed for the better from that moment. I remember the nervousness and the excitement of that day. My family was there to support me, and to encourage me on this special day. I probably did not understand fully the gift that was being given to me, but I knew that this was something different than anything else.

Baptism is the sacrament that changes our lives completely. It takes us from the world and makes us children of God. This is a world changing day for us, as we are invited into a special relationship with God. As we grow, and come to understand our faith and see just how much we need Jesus, we prepare to receive Him in the Eucharist. We first, through baptism, have a place in the Church. Now, through Holy Communion, we have a place at the Altar.

Each time we receive the Eucharist, it is a special moment. It is an opportunity to feel the presence of God, and to let that presence change you. If we are open to the graces we are receiving, we will see the way our lives are changed. The Catechism reminds us, "What material food produces in our bodily life, Holy Communion wonderfully achieves in our spiritual life. Communion with the flesh of the risen Christ, a flesh 'given life and giving life through the Holy Spirit,' preserves, increases, and renews the life of grace received at Baptism."

Anytime we celebrate a sacrament, we are called to examine our own lives and how this sacrament changes us. Are we letting Christ renew us each week? What might be holding us back from this sacrament? These are questions we would love to help you with if you have any struggles or challenges. Please contact one of the priests or deacons to talk to us.

Our First Communion set us on this path, and opened so many doors for us to know Christ and to serve Him with our lives. We pray in a special way for all of our children receiving their First Communion this weekend. May the Bread of the Angels continue to help them navigate the uncertain waters of this world, and may we renew our own hope and trust in the presence of the Lord who is with us each time we receive Him.

Prayer for those Making their First Communion

Lord Jesus, Bless the children coming forward to receive Holy Communion for the first time. May this day be an initial step into a life-long love of the Eucharist.

Give them a hunger for this sacred food so that they turn to You for comfort, guidance, and wisdom as they grow into full discipleship.

Thank you for their innocence and goodness. May their eagerness to receive Your Body and Blood inspire all of us to cherish this Sacred Sacrament. Amen.

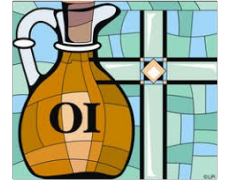

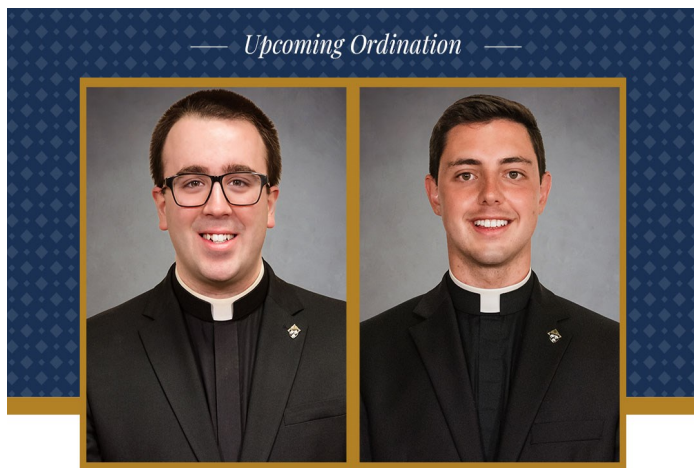

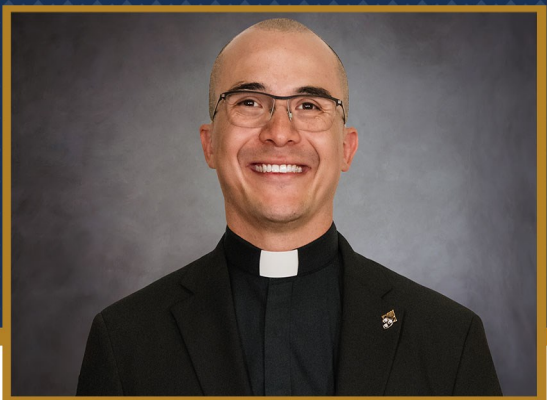

De Nuestro Rector

¿Recuerdas tu Primera Comunión? Para muchos de nosotros, este día paso en un abrir y cerrar de los ojos. Muchos de nosotros éramos niños cuando recibimos por primera vez a Nuestro Señor en la Eucaristía, mientras que otros pueden haber sido adultos. No importa cuándo lo recibimos, sabemos que nuestras vidas cambiaron para el bien a partir de ese momento. Recuerdo el nerviosismo y la emoción de aquel día. Mi familia estaba allí para apoyarme y animarme en este día tan especial. Probablemente no comprendía del todo el regalo que me estaban haciendo, pero sabía que era algo diferente a todo lo demás.

El bautismo es el sacramento que cambia nuestras vidas por completo. Nos saca del mundo y nos nos convierte en hijos de Dios. Es un día en que cambia el mundo para nosotros, ya que se nos invita a una relación especial con Dios. A medida que crecemos, comprendemos nuestra fe y vemos cuánto necesitamos a Jesús, nos preparamos para recibirlo en la Eucaristía. Primero, por el bautismo, tenemos un lugar en la Iglesia.
