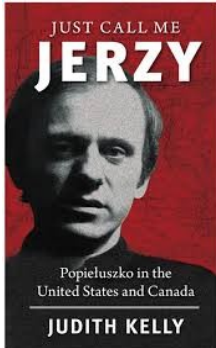
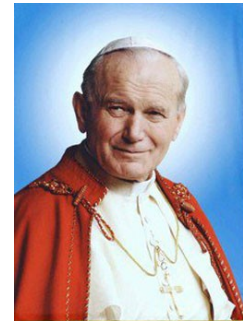

Author Judith Kelly will discuss her book **Just Call Me Jerzy**, which tells the story of a young Polish priest, Jerzy Popiełuszko, who preached peaceful resistance to an oppressive communist government. In 1984, at age 37, he was kidnapped and murdered by members of the Polish secret police.

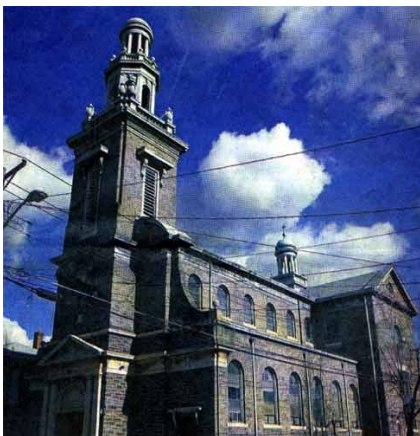
Today, Blessed Jerzy Popiełuszko is a national hero in Poland, recognized as a martyr by the Catholic Church. His cause for sainthood is now being reviewed by the Vatican.
