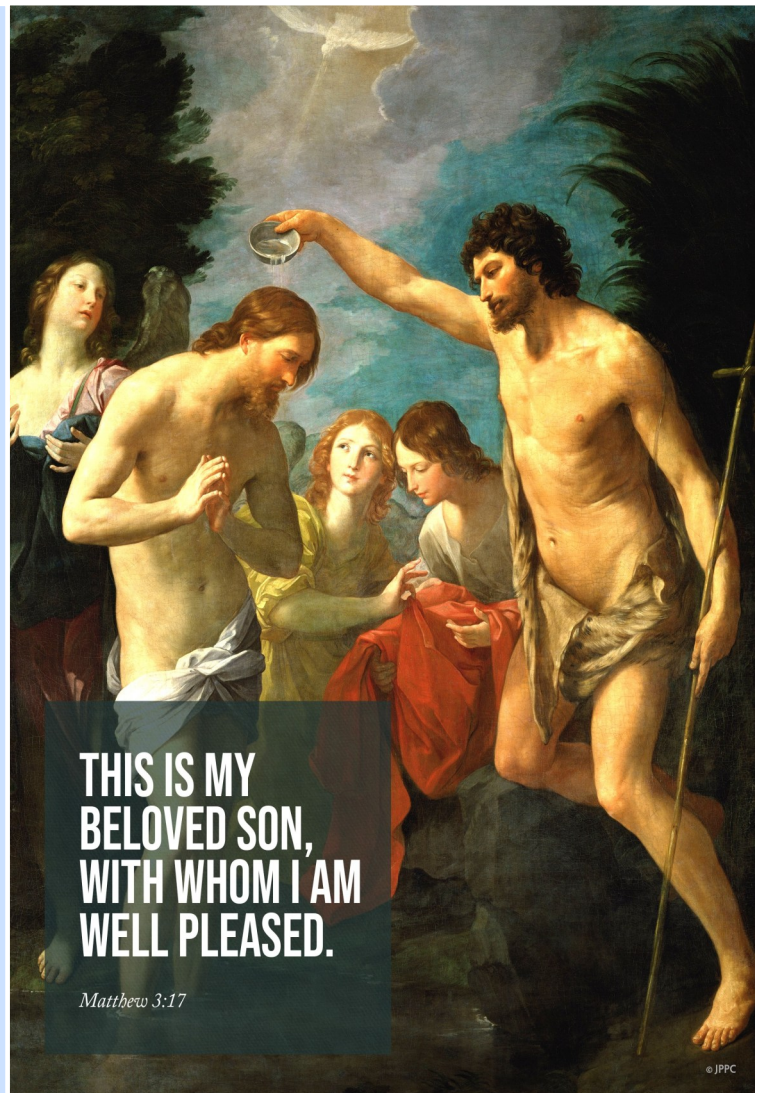

Baptism: For children 7 years of age or younger, parents and godparents (sponsors) must take a baptismal class. The child's birth certificate and a letter of eligibility from the current parish of the parents and godparents, if they are not attending the Cathedral, are required. According to the precepts of the church, all godparents must be 16 years of age or older, practicing the faith, and have completed all of their sacraments. It is possible to have only one sponsor. Baptism may be received at any age. For unbaptized adults, formation is available through the OCIA Program. 856-964-1580 EXT. 103

Religious Education: Our Religious Education program prepares youth (ages 7-15) to receive Baptism, First Communion (children 6 and older), and Confirmation (children 10 and older). Please contact the religious education program at 856-964-1580 EXT. 103. For baptism, registration is open all year round. Call us and we will assist you.

OCIA: Our OCIA program (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults) prepares youth (age 16 and older) and adults to receive baptism, first communion and confirmation. New registrations are taken throughout the year in our religious education office.

Annulment and Marriage: The necessary preparation requires that an appointment be made with one of the priests or deacon. For more information about an annulments, you may also call the Diocese Tribunal Office: 856-583-6162.

Anointing of the Sick: For extreme unction in the case of some who is near death, call day or night at 856-964-1580 and press 2. Call us to schedule an appointment to receive the sacrament before surgery or in case of serious mental or physical illness. For communion visits for sick or elderly parishioners who are unable to attend Mass, call us.

Quinceañeras or Sweet 16: The young lady should have completed or be in preparation to complete her sacraments. If not, Father can offer a blessing for her and we invite her to enroll in our religious education program.

Funerals: In order to plan as best as possible, we ask that the funeral home or the family member in charge of arrangements call us.

**From Our
Permanent Deacon**

With the liturgical feast of the Baptism of the Lord, we conclude the beautiful season of Christmas, when we celebrate the coming of God incarnate. God comes out to meet us. He not only wants us to be with Him, but even more so, He wants to be with us.

Today we celebrate a second Epiphany or Manifestation in which the heavens open during the baptism of Jesus, and with this event a new creation begins. The dove, a sign of the Holy Spirit, descends to inaugurate the beginning of the Kingdom of God, and the voice of the Father proclaims Jesus as his beloved Son in whom He is well pleased.

With this wonderful manifestation, Jesus' glorious mission of salvation begins. It all starts with the recognition of Jesus as the Son of God. It is the event that drives Jesus throughout his public ministry to be faithful to God his Father. He never lost the filial vision of his identity. Are we aware of our identity as children of God? Do we see in the sacrament of our baptism the promise of salvation that our parents chose for us? This recognition is a powerful affirmation of who we are, but it is also challenging and requires us to respond and act. This plan of salvation is open to all, and that is why we invite those who are not baptized to join us as children of God in this sacrament of the Holy Church. The greatest crisis facing human beings today is not recognizing their true identity in Christ.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church states:
537 Through Baptism the Christian is sacramentally assimilated to Jesus, who in his own baptism anticipates his death and resurrection. The Christian must enter into this mystery of humble self-abasement and repentance, go down into the water with Jesus in order to rise with him, be reborn of water and the Spirit so as to become the Father's beloved son in the Son and "walk in newness of life"

Let us follow the advice of St. Gregory Nazianzen: *"Let us be buried with Christ through baptism so that we may rise with him; let us descend with him so that we may ascend with him. Let us ascend with him so that we may be glorified with him."*
